

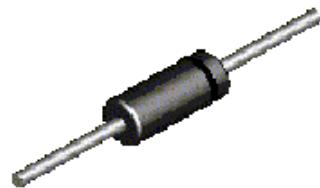

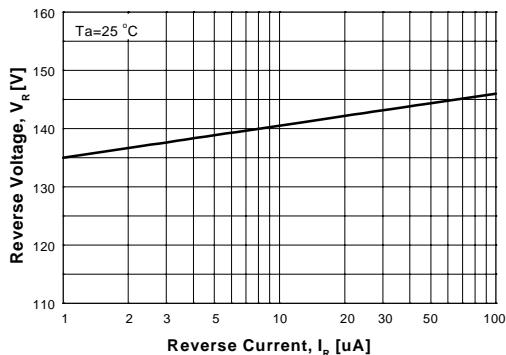
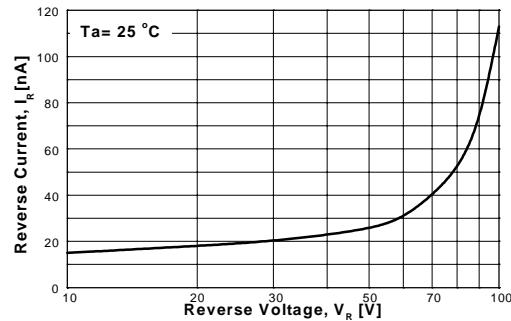


Figure 1. Reverse Voltage vs Reverse Current

IR - 10 to 100 V

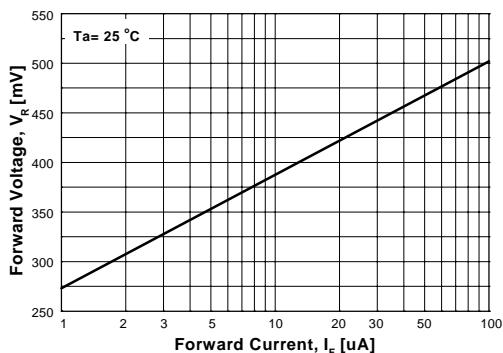


Figure 3. Forward Voltage vs Forward Current  
VF - 1 to 100  $\mu\text{A}$

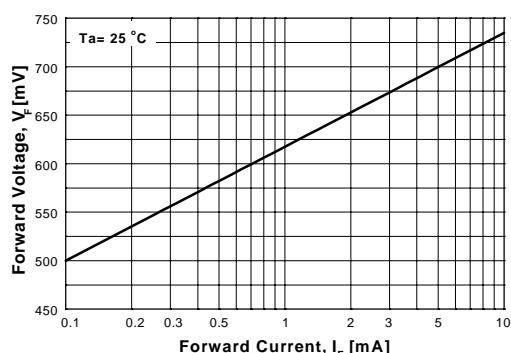
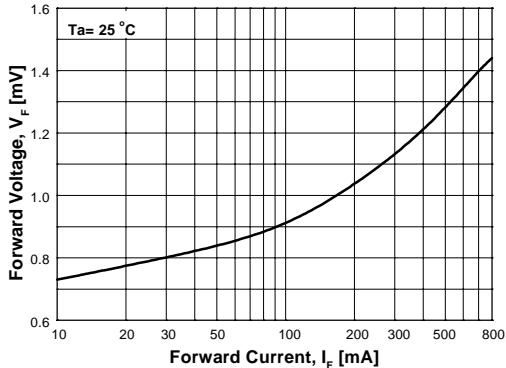


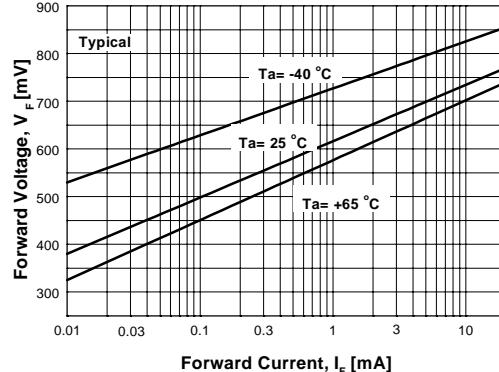
Figure 4. Forward Voltage vs Forward Current

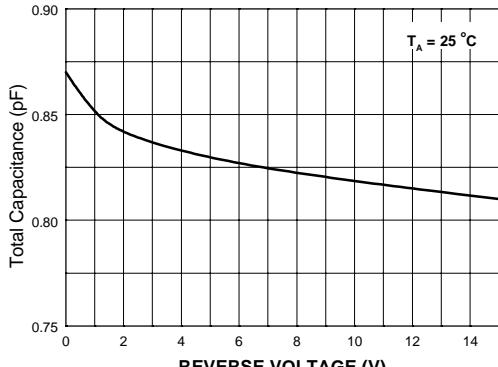

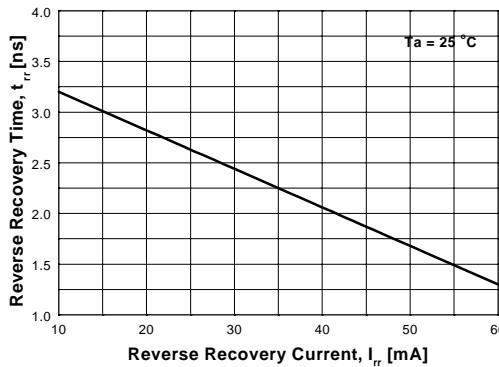
**Figure 5. Forward Voltage vs Forward Current**  
VF - 10 to 800 mA



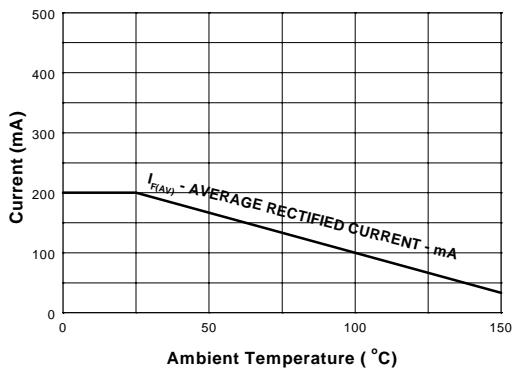
**Figure 6. Forward Voltage**

VF - 0.01 - 20 mA (-40 to +65 Deg C)



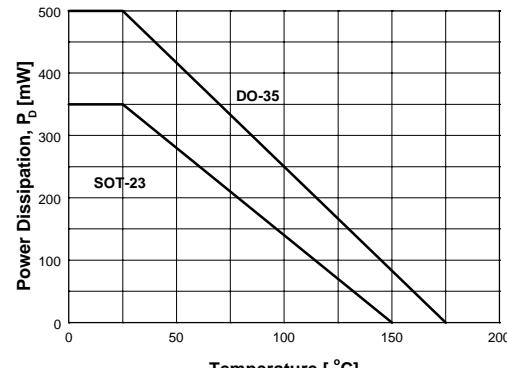
**Figure 7. Total Capacitance**
